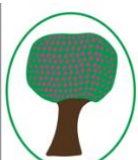

Just to keep everyone updated – Trina Bunn is currently Acting Head of Care and Abby Baker is Acting Deputy at Russell House.



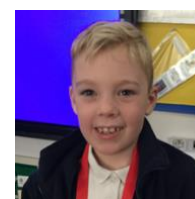
7W News
