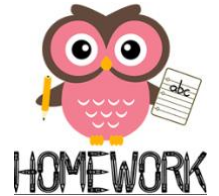

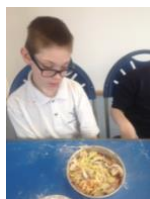
BIRCH and HOLLY Classes

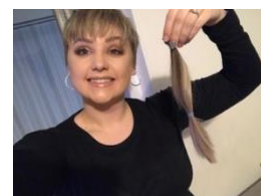
