A reminder for end of term procedure for medicines.

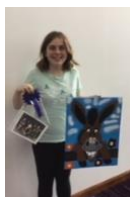
At the end of term all medicines for children/young people will be sent home as they cannot be stored in school over the summer holidays.

Yew Class have been Pizza Making!!

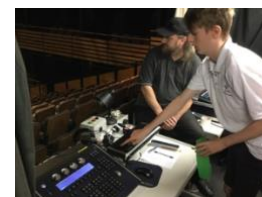

10I Dance Extravaganza

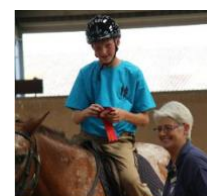
