## Bunsen Burner Licence

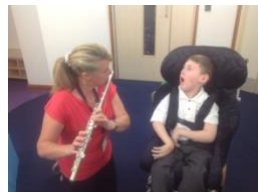
Thrive class have been very excited this week to finally get their bunsen burner licence!
