9DG have begun to look at plant cells. Ben and Beth have created microscope slides showing the tiny cells that make up the leaves on moss. Amazing images!



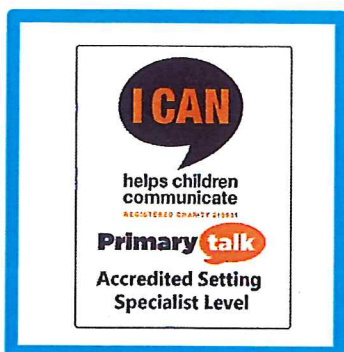
BIRCH & Willow Parents ... Don't forget
