Children in Need – Friday 16th November

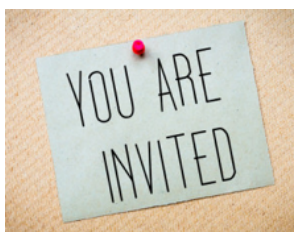
