Students are asked to bring in a £1 donation for Comic Relief.

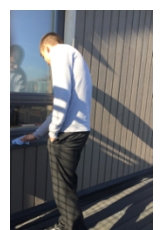
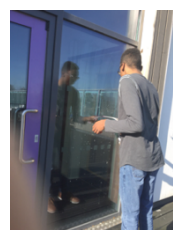
Class 7P will be selling red noses in the week running up to Red Nose Day which will cost £1.25 each.

Please send your child in with money if they would like to purchase one, thank you. (These are delivered in sealed boxes so children will not be able to choose which one they would prefer).



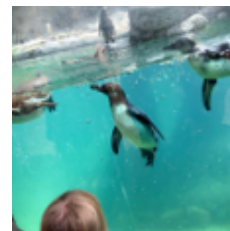
**13S – Learning Independent Living Skills**

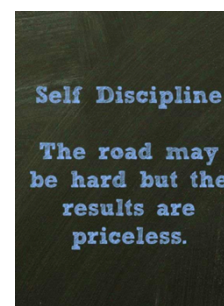
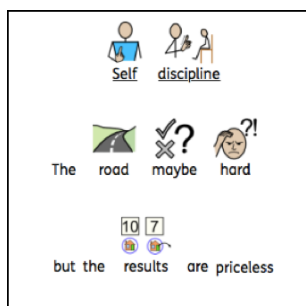
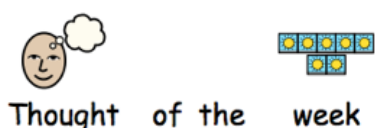


## February Half Term Holiday Club News
