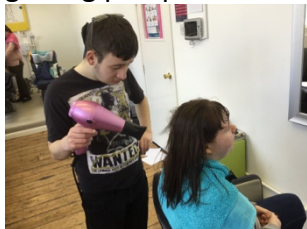
All of the children listened, joined in everything and looked after each other taking turns and celebrating each other's successes.



We were very proud of Birch Class.

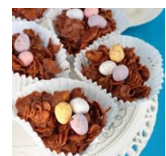
12G News
