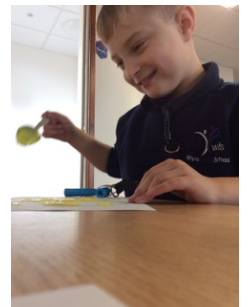
We are accepting people wishing to express just an interest at the moment for a place at Russell House (weekly boarding unit) from September 2021.

## Summer Holiday Club News

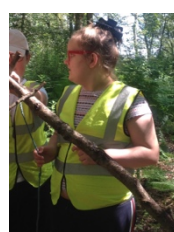
We had a fantastic four weeks in Holiday Club with smiles all round.
