Important Message from Mrs Garratt

Hoists!

Unfortunately, when the school was designed and built, no inspection hatches were put in to provide acccess to check the hoist fixtures over the hydro pool and over the trampoline. The insurance providers have informed us that we cannot use the hoists until it is rectified. This will impact on the pupils who require hoisting in to / out of the pool and the trampoline. The Governors are working tirelessly to get Worcestershire County Council to make good on the original build. They have said they will pay and fix the problem, but have yet to provide timescales for the work. When they do, I will of course let you know. EVERY Monday 1:45-2:45 in the sports hall at school.


