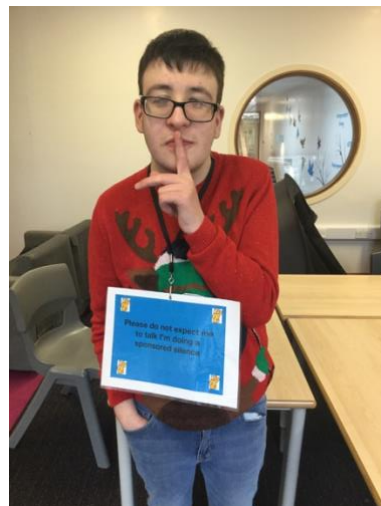
### Class 7A Reminders to Parents
