"I made some Cakes yesterday and went to the shed to work out on the cross trainer."

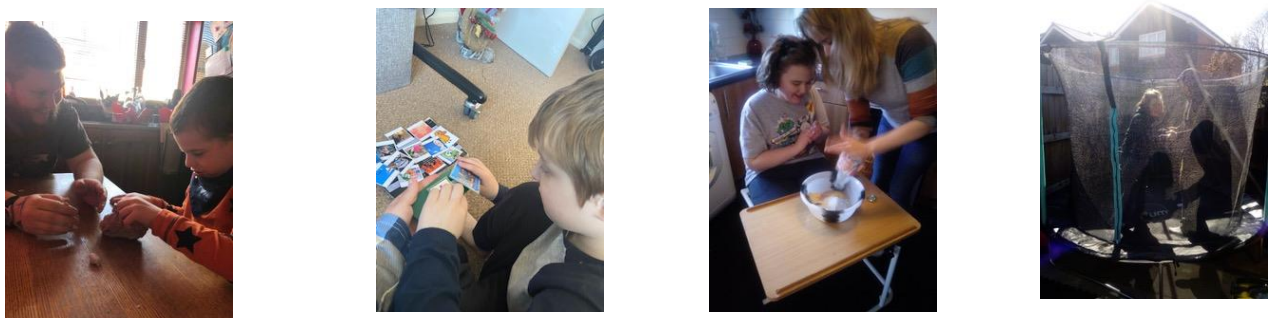


CHESTNUT Class

HAZEL Class

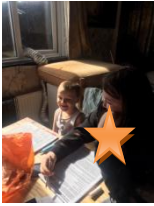


Here are some examples from this week's home learning from Hazel class.

Ethan made an amazing aquarium as his model habitat with all of his own ideas and Josh has been working really hard on his Number work involving understanding money and making totals.



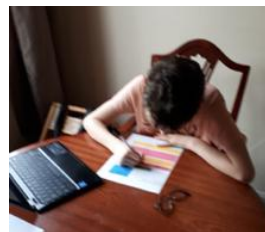
