You can find resources related to Covid-19 on our website below. We are adding new resources every week.



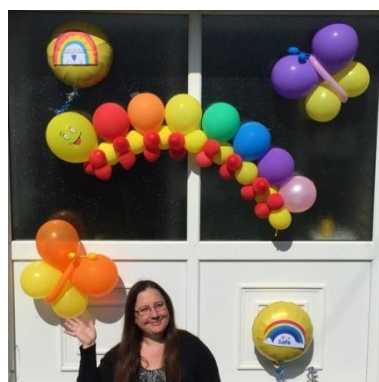
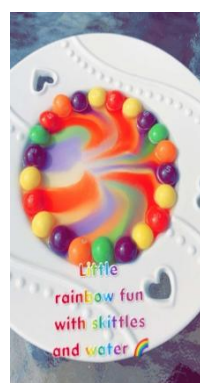

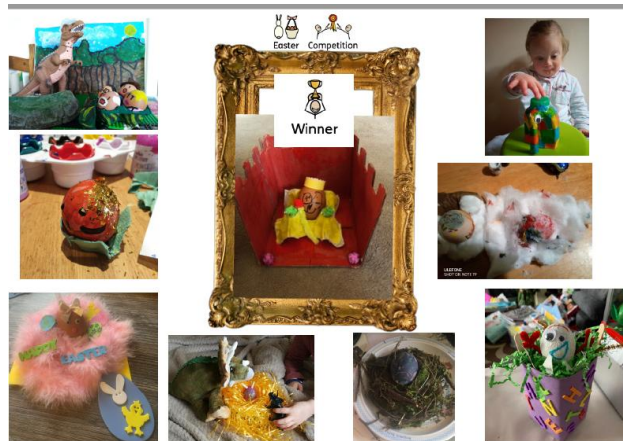

Getting through COVID-19

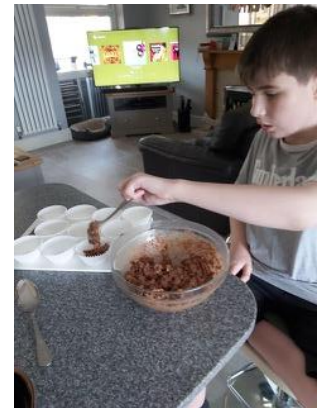


We hope you enjoyed your Easter Holidays and didnt eat too much chocolate!

BEECH Class have been giving music lessons, making their own lunches, enjoying a dough disco and learning to 'take turns' when playing games with family members.



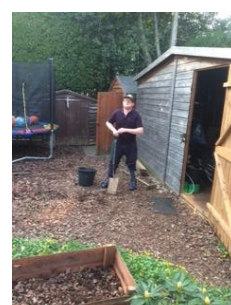

WOODLANDS Class have been having fun at home and finding things whilst out on a walk with Parents.



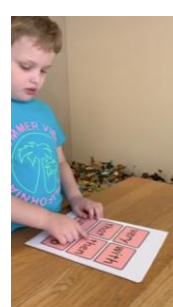
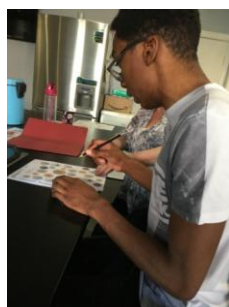
Harry from Class 14S is learning so much about the jobs that need to be done at home, washing, gardening, cleaning the patio...the jobs never end!
