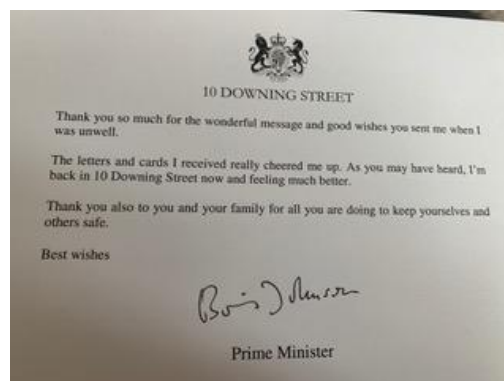


## Newsletter Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2020

I wonder what Boris would make of Mrs G's new 'social distancing' hat and mask – courtesy of Sarn???

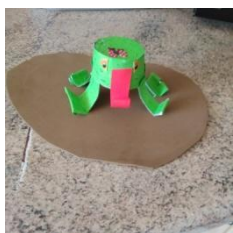
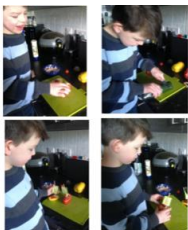


WOODLANDS Class theme is 'Around the World in 80 Days' – this week they went to Egypt on their virtual travels!

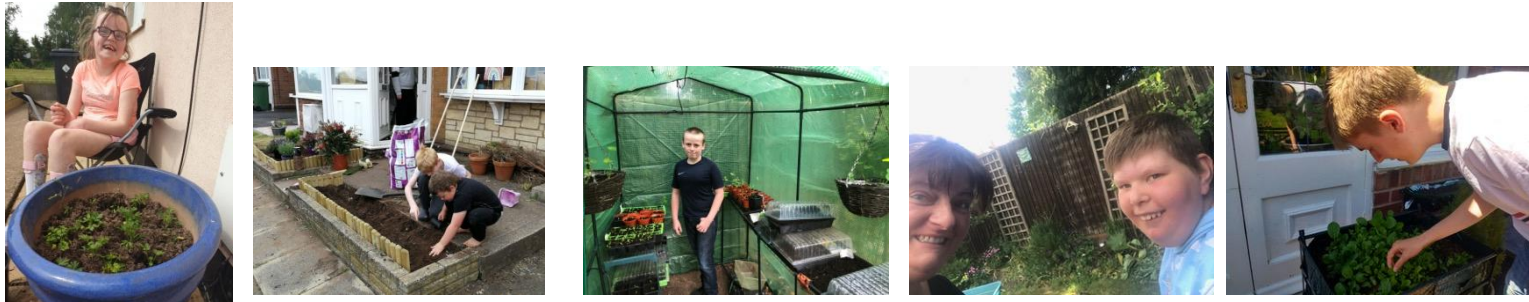
CHERRY Class have been learning about habitats and about the life cycle of frogs. They made a frog jump game too.

Lots of students have been out enjoying the sunshine



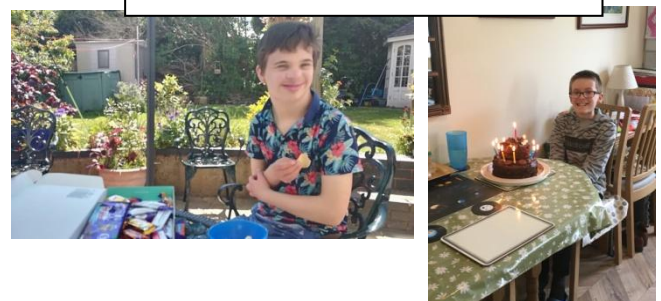
Tom helped shear the fleece of a sheep and bag it up!

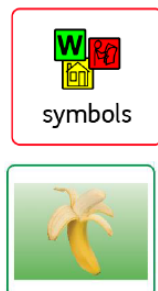


### Communication Tip – Use a Total Communication Approach

Total communication means using words, objects, photographs, pictures, signs and symbols when we are communicating



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Using a total communication approach helps children to understand us when we are talking.

Use words, objects, sign or natural gesture, point to photographs, pictures and symbols.

This also helps children to develop their preferred means or way of communicating with us.
