The Class Team posted out sunflower seeds to all pupils – lets see which one is the tallest in a few weeks!



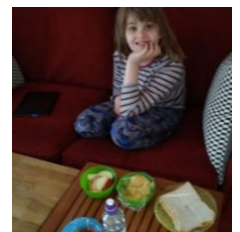
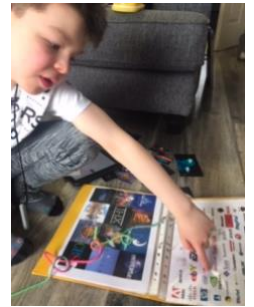
WOODLANDS Class theme is 'Around the World in 80 Days' – this week they went to Kenya on their virtual travels!

BEECH Class were exploring the story of Goldilocks and the three bears last week and Beth has created her own daddy bear, mummy bear and baby bear - Great work Beth!



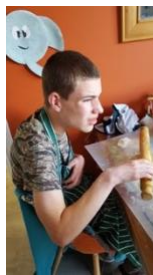

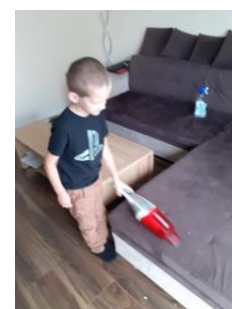
