Welcome Back Message from Mrs Garratt.



Welcome back everyone. The children have been amazing and an absolute credit to you all. I cannot tell you how happy I felt on Monday when all the children were back, it was such wonderful day and everyone just got on with the new way of working - no problems! Our attendance has been fantastic (92%).

Many thanks to all the parents who have supported our new approach to entering and exiting the school. This has worked well and we are continuing to review this on a daily basis to ensure that we can make the areas around the school as safe as possible. Just a reminder to parents that staff are unable to have conversations at handover and any communication should be requested or emailed / telephoned across. In addition, it is important that parents drop off / collect and go quickly to ensure that social distancing and covid hygiene measures can be maintained. From Monday 14th September the arrival time is <u>still</u> 9.00am for those that are brought in by parents although we will open the gates earlier than 9 to alleviate some of the queuing and congregating of parents at the various entrances. Please support us by arriving between 8.50 and 9am as this will make the flow of parents much smoother.

I know we appear very strict with our protocols, but we have had to produce very detailed risk assessments and plans that have been approved by the Local Authority and Public Health. We therefore must adhere to these to remain open. We cannot allow for early collection as we do not have the flexibility to allow staff to come out of bubbles. I know it's frustrating but we want to keep our school open as long as possible.

Please do not send your child in if you know they are unwell. We are currently taking no chances and this can be very selfish, as we have some very vulnerable pupils and staff. Also, if you have COVID-19 symptoms in your household can you let us know and also the results of your test so we can be prepared if we need to act.
