Important Information for Parents..



As you are all aware, it's been another busy week at Wyre Forest School! We've taken Government guidance and decided to close the school on Friday 18th December, therefore the last day pupils are in school will be <u>Thursday 17th December 2020</u> and they will return on Tuesday 5th January 2021.

We sent every Parent an email with a letter attached explaining what to do if your child develops symptoms on either Friday 18th, Saturday 19th Or Sunday 20th December – A copy of the letter is included in this newsletter.

It's been all hands-on deck this week as we have no catering staff. Mrs Birch and Mrs Hardiman from the office staff and Deputy Head Mrs Kehoe have been preparing toast for all of our children, whilst myself, Mrs Kehoe (again!) and Assistant Head Mrs Thompson have been serving lunches and washing up after all the meals!

Dear All,

I know several parents have said they are keeping their children at home next week so that they will be well over the Christmas holiday and will be safe to see Grandparents etc. As a school I cannot condone this but personally, with an elderly mother, I totally understand. I hope I will be able to see my mom over Christmas as I haven't seen her for such a long time and as both mom and I live in South Staffordshire (Tier 3) it's been really difficult.

We will not be pursuing families for non-attendance during this difficult time. Let's hope the vaccine rolls out quickly and we can get back to normality as soon as possible.

As you may have heard in the news the Government have given us permission to close the school on the 18th December. This means I will be on call to support the track and trace until 23rd December and not the 24th December as previously planned.

Our last day will be Thursday 17th December and we will return Tuesday 5th January.

Russell House will also close on Thursday 17th and all residents will go home that night on their usual transport.

We have also made Transport aware of this change.

I apologise for the short notice of this and the impact it will have on you, but I hope you know we have worked really hard to keep as much of the school open as possible whilst keeping staff and pupils safe. This has had its toll on staff and we are struggling to safely staff classes. This day will help enormously.

If your child displays symptoms on Friday 18th, Saturday 19th or Sunday 20th you must email me at head@wfs.worcs.sch.uk and go and get a test. You then need to notify me of the test results at head@wfs.worcs.sch.uk Fingers crossed this does not happen and I do not have to contact families to self-isolate over Christmas.

Thank you so much for your continued support - it really means a lot.
