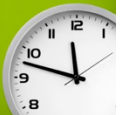

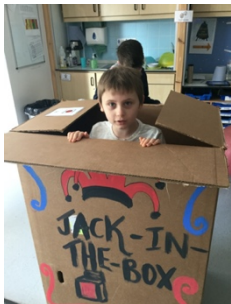

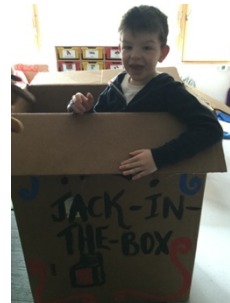

This week Willow Class have been making pictures of the Milky Way using chalk and paint to create our pictures.



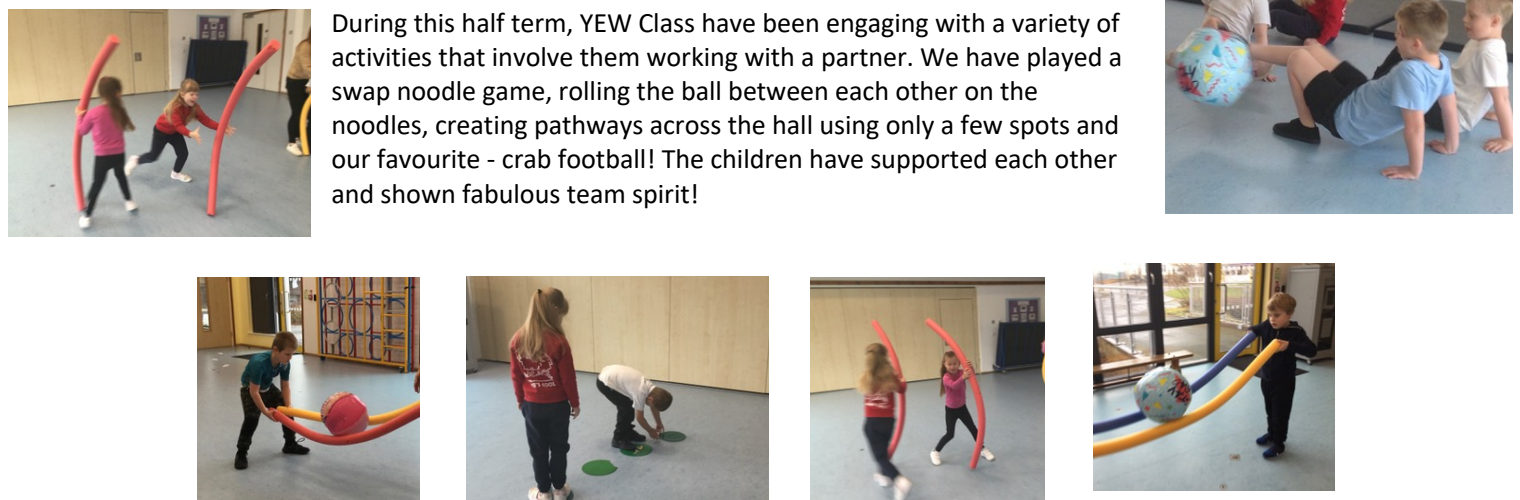
ELM Class

Cookery with Class 9W

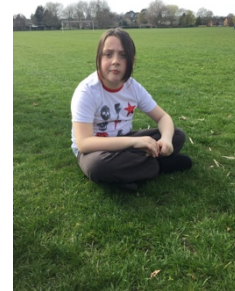
