OAK & PINE Class

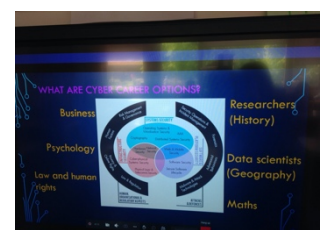

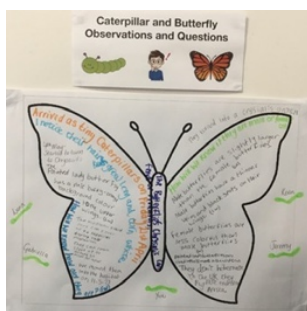
12S

Cooking at Wyre Forest

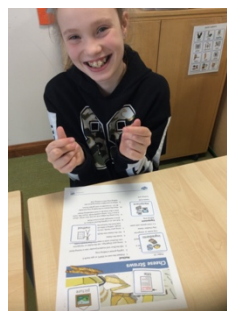
