Youth Club

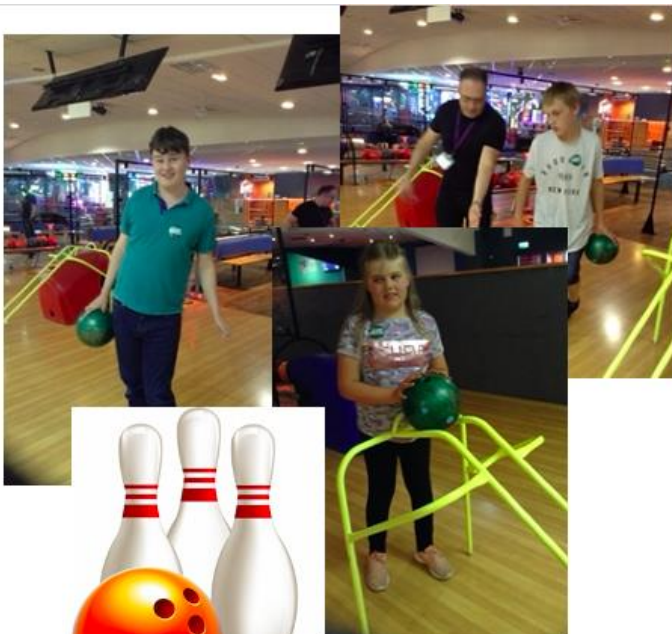
