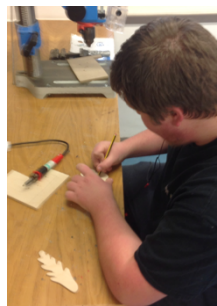


Maple class have made a wreath in recognition of Remembrance Day. They used potato stamps to make the poppy shape for the wreath.
