Sycamore Center







Swimming

Every Tuesday we go swimming, we enjoy playing with he floats and playing ball games.




Cricket

This term we have been attending a cricket club in Redditch, here we get to practice throwing and catching a ball, understand and participate in team work.


Each week we have seen the students build confidence in the sport and meet new people.

We will be ready for The Ashes in no time.

















On Site Activities






Youth Club
