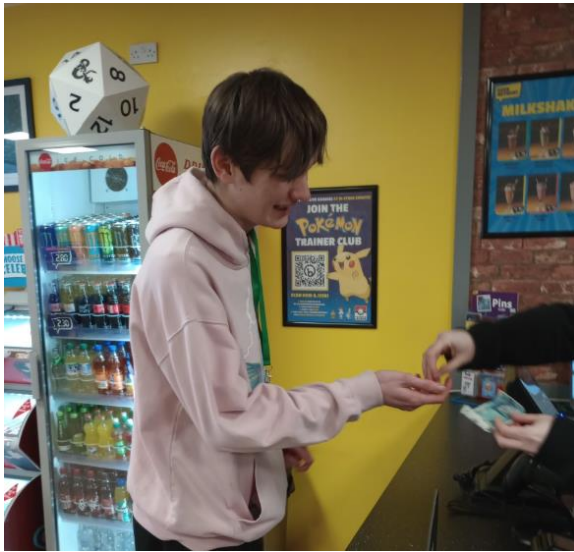

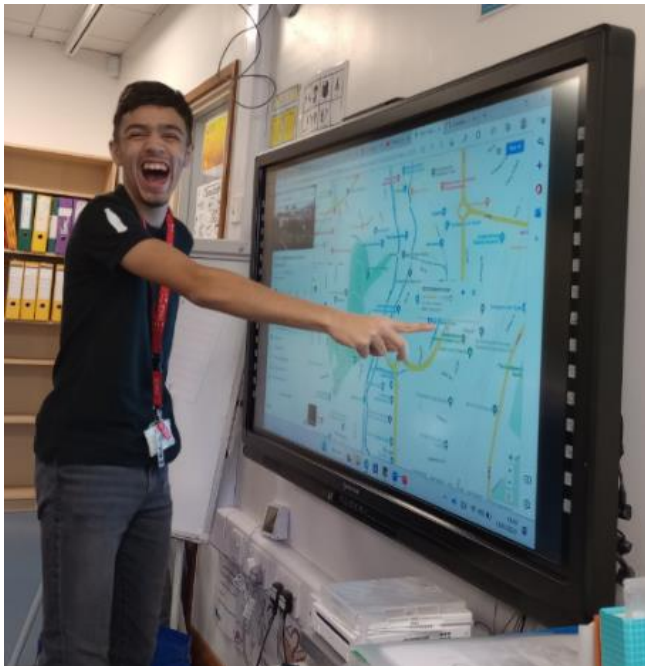

In 12W this week we have been exploring facilities in our local area. We used Google maps to support our research.

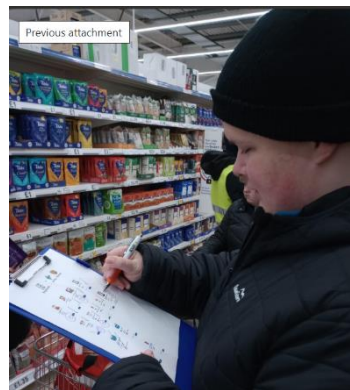
This week in Healthy Living 12W practiced some yoga moves.
