The children all had a lovely time last week at our Coronation picnic.







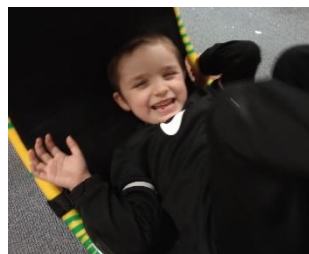
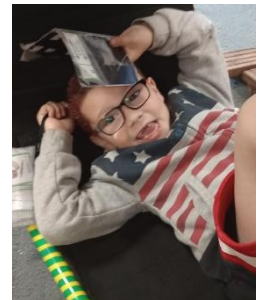
## HAWTHORN Class

## 11H



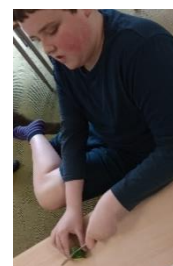

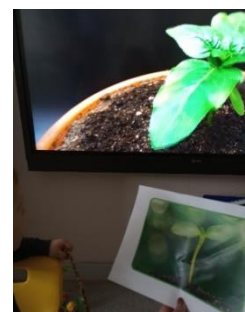

Our highlight of the week was our first ever visit to the new playground equipment, where we were able to practice our climbing, waiting and turn taking.

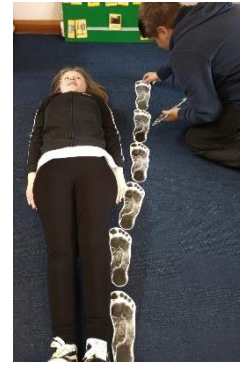


We look forward to seeing our parents next Friday afternoon at 1.30 for our summer themed stay and play.
