Playing musical instruments

Musical instruments are a great way to develop children's communication development. Instruments can be used to encourage your child's listening and attention skills, whilst building relationships with adults/peers.



 Gather bells, drums, tambourines or even make your very own shakers with different materials inside



 Tell your child how to play e.g, 'You play fast' or 'You play loud' and model this to them.



 Practice other concepts such as stop, go, slow and quiet



- Take turns on how the instruments are played
- Praise them when they are doing 'good listening'
- Have fun!
