School Nursing Team Message

The School Nurses and First-Aid team are working to improve the health of children in school with asthma as part of 'Guidance on the use of emergency inhalers in school' Department of Health 2015.

We sent home a form this week asking parents to complete and sign if they are happy for the school's Salbutamol inhaler to be used in the event of an emergency. Only completed forms can be added to the asthma register in school. The register will then be reviewed annually. When the register and emergency inhaler are in school, it remains your responsibility to ensure that your child has a working, in-date emergency Salbutamol inhaler in school at all times.
