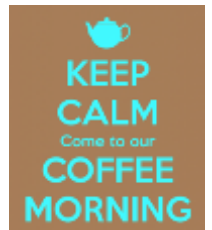

Year 10 have been making their own pasta this week, and you can see them hard at work with the pasta machine. The perfectly produced

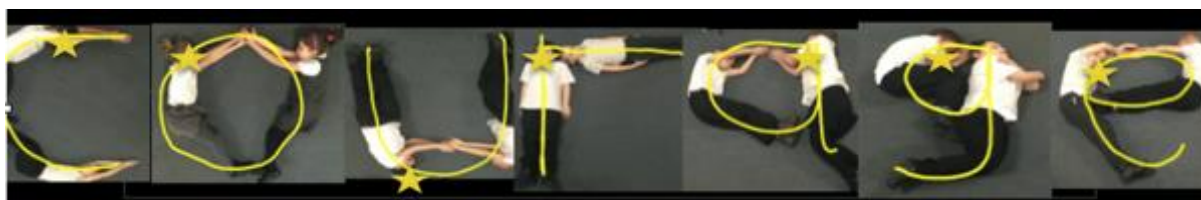
tagliatelle was then used in our parmesan and mustard chicken dish. Very delicious along with home-made parmesan crisps. Yum!
