## Peter Collins Class



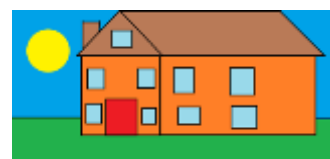
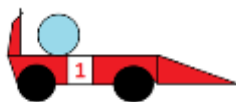
Peter Collins class hosted an afternoon tea on Wednesday afternoon.
